Québec has significant mining potential that accounts for one fifth of Canada's mineral production. The province produces and develops about 30 commodities, making it the most diverse resource base in Canada.

Québec contributes to supplying critical and strategic minerals, since it produces nickel, niobium, lithium, graphite, copper, zinc, cobalt and platinum group elements and mining projects are underway for lithium, vanadium, rare earth elements, tantalum and phosphate.

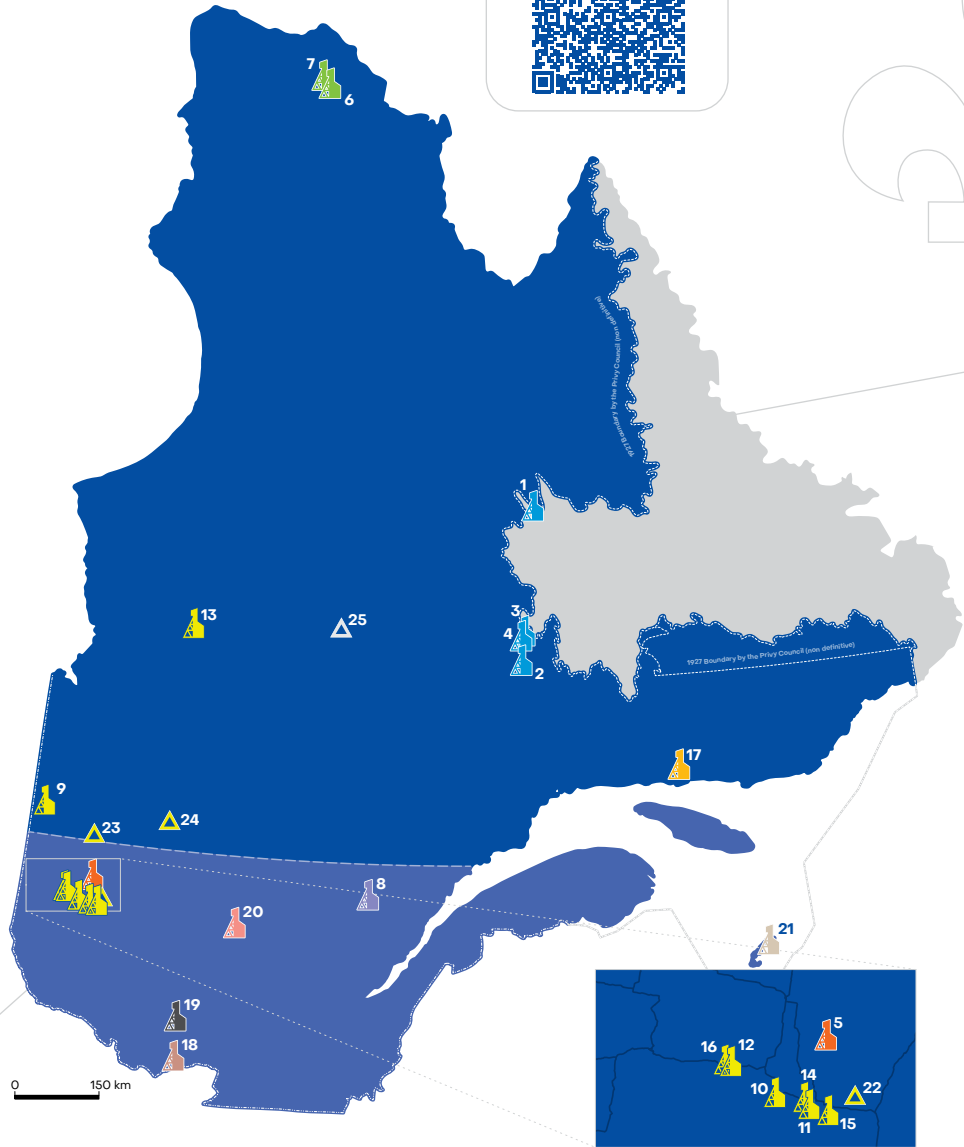

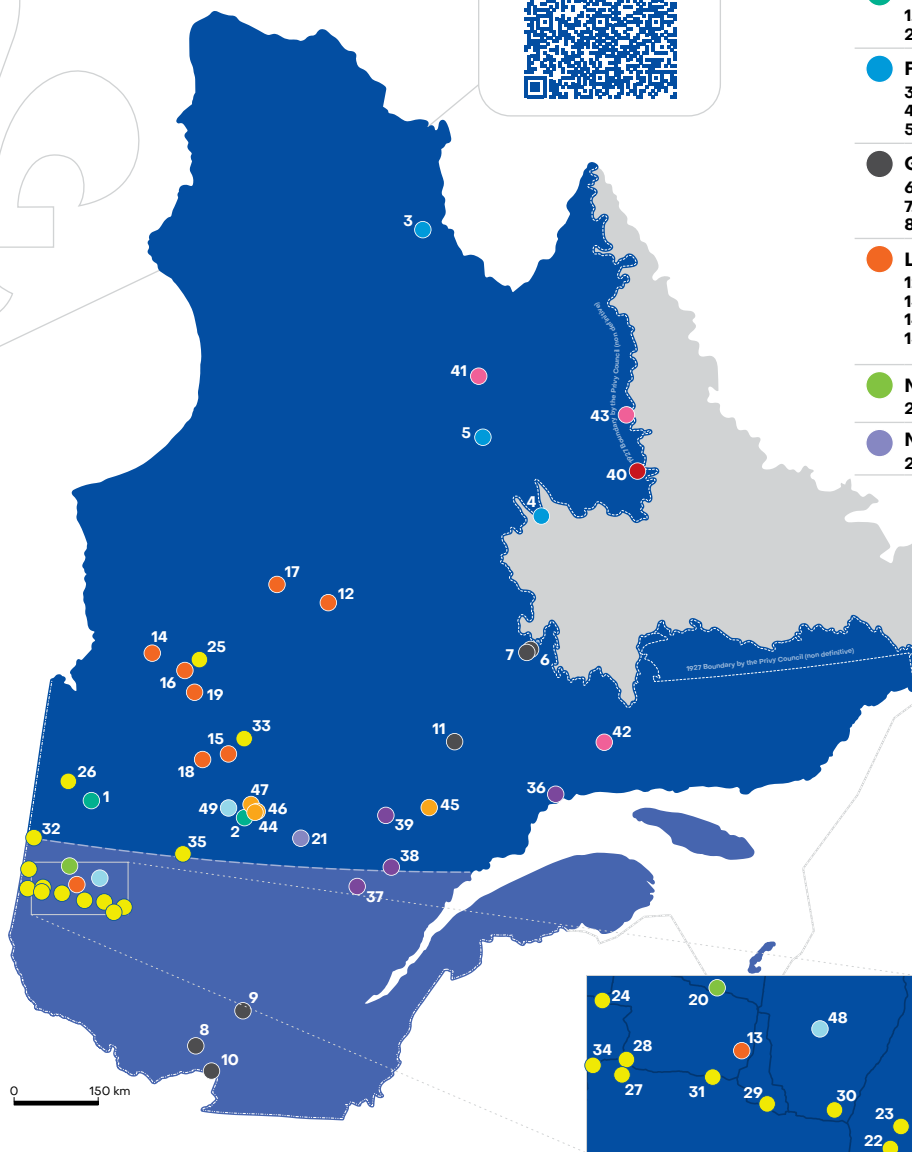
